Mr Nabi: Mr Nabi will be an invaluable member of our inclusion department, providing tailored support and interventions to help our students succeed.

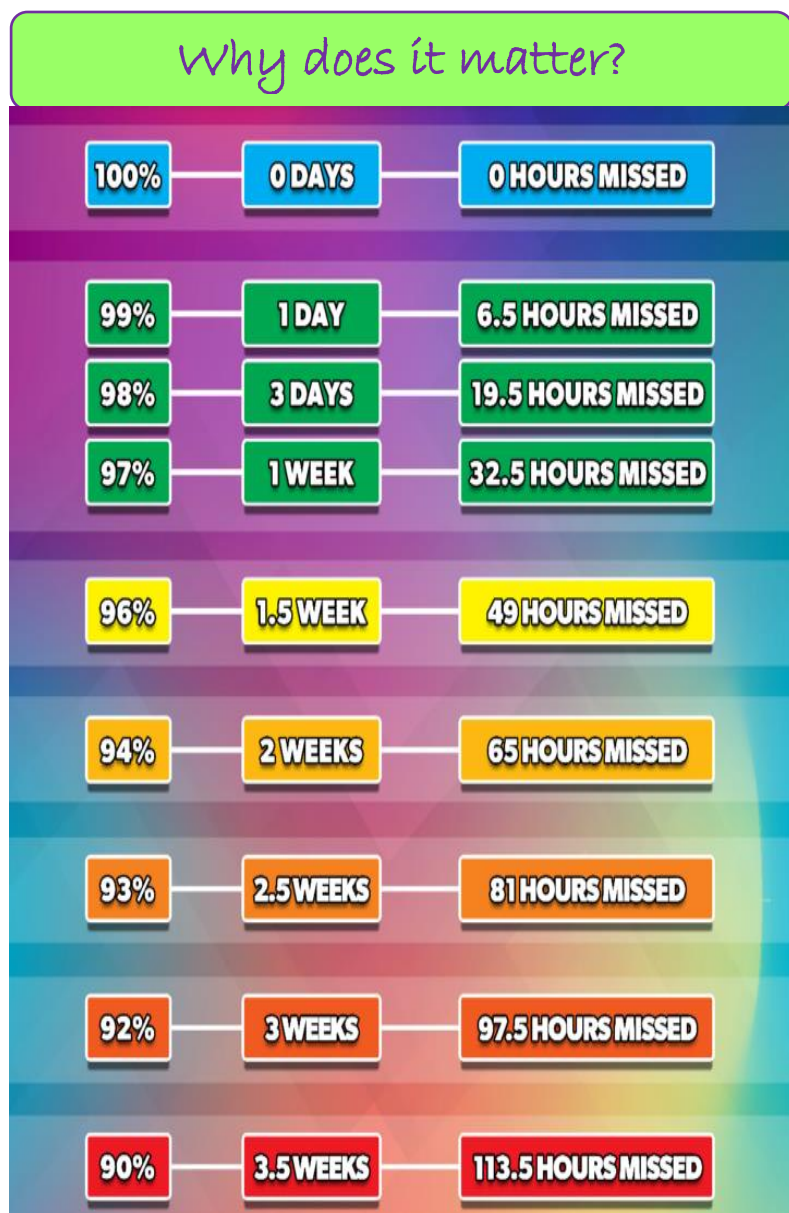
The 'Highfield Promise'
