



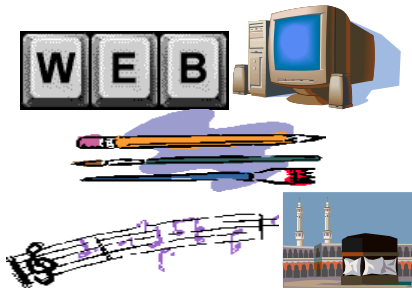


<p><b>Writing</b></p> 	<p><b>Purpose of the writing: <u>Writing to Inform</u></b></p> <p><b>We will be learning:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To understand the organisational features of a Information text.</li><li>• To understand the language features of a Information</li><li>• To begin to understand main clause and subordinate clause</li><li>• To write in paragraphs - developing ideas logically</li><li>• To continue to use range of connectives, punctuations and sentence openers</li></ul>
<p><b>Reading and Phonics</b></p> 	<p><b>We will be...</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Reading a range of key words on sight.</li><li>• Using our knowledge of phonics to decode and blend unfamiliar words.</li><li>• Reading with expression, taking punctuation into account.</li><li>• To identify features of a non-fiction text - looking closely at index, contents and glossary page.</li><li>• Retrieving information using contents page and index page</li><li>• To understand 'who' 'what' 'where' questions.</li><li>• To answer test type questions.</li></ul>
<p><b>Numeracy</b></p> 	<p><b>Focus: Place Value</b></p> <p><b>We are learning about...</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To add and subtract numbers pictorially and in abstract</li><li>• Answer reasoning questions related to addition and subtraction</li><li>• Learning our times tables (2x, 5x, 3x and 10x)</li><li>•</li></ul>

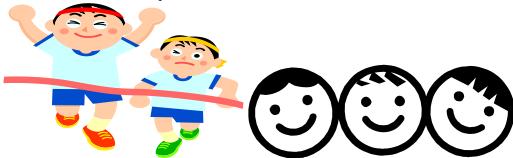
