Reading:


In our guided reading time we will have opportunities to practise segmenting and blending to read a range of different things such as fiction, non-fiction and poetry.

The children will answer who, what, why and where questions to deepen their understanding of the text.

Phonics: The children are working in eight phonic groups across the year group. They are practising segmenting and blending sounds to read. We are practising for the Year 1 Phonics Screening Test.



P.E

This term in P.E children will explore dance. They will:

Respond to a range of stimuli and types of music

Explore space, direction, levels and speeds

Experiment creating actions and performing movements with different body parts

Children will also learn to hit objects with hand or bat and track and retrieve a rolling ball.



Computing: This term in computing we will learn how to be 'responsible users' when using the internet.

We will continue to develop our knowledge of 'Algorithms'. We will explore the different features of a camera and how to use it to capture moving images

Learning for Life

This term children will be learning about places and landmarks in their local area. We will be looking at maps and learning to identify different map symbols. We will explore the four different countries which make up the UK.
