<p>Reading and Phonics</p> 	<p>We will be...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading a range of key words on sight. • Using our knowledge of phonics to decode and blend unfamiliar words. • To know the difference between literal and inferential questions. • To make inferences from a video clip (to understand, ask and answer inference questions) • To make inferences from a text (looking at characters feelings, thoughts and motive through actions) • To answer test type questions.
<p>Numeracy</p> 	<p>Focus: Multiplication and Division/Statistics</p> <p>We are learning about...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To multiply and divide 2 digits by 1 digit using concrete, pictorial and abstract methods • Answer reasoning questions related to multiplication and division • Learning our times tables (2x, 5x, 3x, 4x and 8x) • Understanding how to use pictograms, bar charts and tables • Answer reasoning questions related to statistics
<p>Science</p> 	<p>Topic: The Human Body (Bones and Muscles)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Looking at the major bones in the human body • Understanding the functions of the skeleton • Looking at the major muscle groups in the human body • Understanding the functions of muscles • Investigating how the bones and muscles work together • Understanding the importance of staying fit and healthy
