Writing

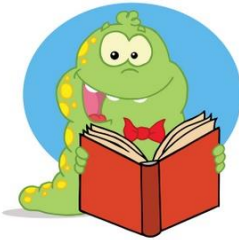


Genre: Stories from Familiar Authors

Focus: Place Value/Addition/Subtraction

We are learning to:

- Compare and order numbers up to 1000
- Find 10 and 100 more or less than a given number
- Add and subtract numbers mentally
- Add and subtract numbers with up to 3 digits using formal written methods

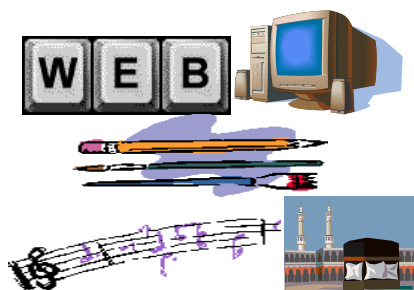
Science

Topic- Stone Age

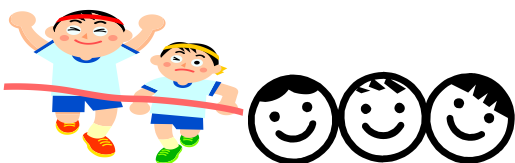
Learning through: History, Geography, Music, Art and Design
