

Year 4 Autumn Term – 1

Maths	<p>Place Value: The pupils will learn about Roman Numerals, learning to write and read Roman Numerals up to 100 (and in some cases 1000). Following this the pupils will then look at place value. They will also look at reading and writing up to 5 digit numbers, recognising the place value of each column and rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.</p> <p>Calculation: Children will learn column methods of addition and subtraction. They will practise these in the arithmetic format as well as solving real-life situation problems. They will also look at multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. Finally the pupils will look at fractions including recognising the decimal and percentage equivalent of common fractions.</p>
English	<p>Genre: Narrative The pupils will look at character and setting descriptions and adding adjectives and adverbials to describe. The pupils will also look at writing to inform and writing to persuade all based around their topic of invasions</p> <p>Reading: The pupils will practice reading aloud and examine the words contained within a text including looking at their definitions and how they contribute to meaning. They will also begin to practice and improve their comprehension skills.</p>
Science	<p>Teeth: The pupils will study the teeth that we have within the human body. They will examine the impact of diet on teeth and what different teeth are used for.</p>
LFL	<p>Topic: Invasions Learning through: History, Geography, Art and Design Pupils will examine invasions through looking at Ancient Rome. They will discover the civilization of the Ancient Romans by studying their cultures and customs. The pupils will then examine the Romans invasion of Britain including studying the Iceni rebellion led by Queen Boudicca.</p>
RE	<p>Living by rules, pupils will learnt to live by rules and to talk about the need for rules in society. The pupils will also look at being merciful and forgiving by examining the meaning of forgiveness and why it is important.</p>
PE	<p>Please remember to bring your P.E. Kits in on a Monday and Thursday. Your child will be developing their physical skills through: Netball – learning how to defend and attack, learning the rules of the handball game and the passing and throwing skills involved.</p> <p>Gymnastics: Children will create their own sequences of balances and movements that involve their partner and other apparatus. Children will learn how to carry and use apparatus safely.</p> <p>Swimming – Until February classes 4K and 4AA will be going swimming at Stetchford Swimming Baths every Thursday. Please send children with all of the appropriate equipment.</p>
Homework	<p>We currently give homework out on a Friday and collect it in on a Thursday. Homework will support the learning in class that week or prepare the children for the following weeks learning.</p>
