

### Year 5 Autumn Term 1.1

<b>Maths</b>	<p>Topic: Number - Place value Children will read, write, order and compare numbers to at least 1000000 and determine the value of each digit. They will Interpret negative numbers in context, count forwards and backwards with positive and negative whole numbers. Children will round numbers to 10, 100, 1000, 10000 and 100000.</p> <p>Topic: Addition and Subtraction In this topic, the children will be looking at adding and subtracting whole numbers with more than 4 digits including using the formal written methods.</p> <p>Topic: Statistics Children will solve comparison, sum and difference problems using information presented in a line graph. They will read and interpret information in tables including timetables.</p>
<b>Reading</b>	<p>Topic – predictions – we will be discussing what the word prediction means and the children will be making a prediction based on the book Inference – Children will be looking at how to make inferences based on the characters thoughts and feeling. They will be using the evidence to support their answers. We will be covering a range of test style questions.</p>
<b>English</b>	<p>Topic: Film narrative Children will be watching the movie ‘How to train your dragon’ and exploring the different skills and language they would use when writing a narrative. They will explore setting and character descriptions, as well as beginning to understand how a plot is developed and sustained.</p> <p>Journalistic writing: In this topic, children will be looking at how news reports are written through their language and organisational features.</p> <p>Poet’s voice: In this topic, we will be looking at a range of Viking related poetry and how the poet conveys different ideas through the language and structure choices.</p>
<b>Science</b>	<p>Living things: In this topic, children will explore lifecycles of different animals and plants. They will be learning a range of technical scientific vocabulary.</p>
<b>LFL</b>	<p>Topic: The Vikings This term we are looking at The Vikings. Children will be exploring where The Vikings came from, where they invaded and what life was like for The Vikings.</p>
<b>RE</b>	<p>Topic: Caring for the world: Children to look at different ways that people care for the world. We will also look at ways that different religions care</p> <p>Topic: Steadfastness – we will look at how different religions show the quality of steadfastness such as Christianity - good Samaritan</p> <p>Topic: Hope – we will look how religions show hope – Christmas story and discuss how Jesus brought hope to the Christians</p>
<b>PE</b>	<p>Please remember to bring your P.E. Kits in on a Monday and Tuesday. 5H and 5C will be going Swimming on Thursday’s and therefore need the appropriate kit.</p>
<b>Homework</b>	<p>We currently give homework out on a Friday and receive it back on a Wednesday. Children have 1 Maths piece and 1 English piece with spellings going out each week.
