


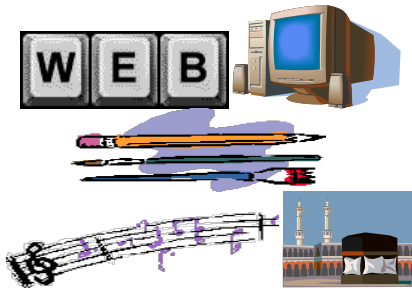

Topic- Ancient Egypt

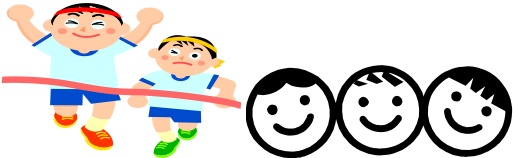
Learning through: History, Geography, Music, Art and Design
