


<p>Writing</p> 	<p>Purpose of the writing: Writing to Persuade/Writing to Entertain</p> <p>We will be learning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To understand the organisational features of an advert • To understand the language features of an advert • To understand and correctly use persuasive language and rhetorical questions • To explore the genre of myths and legends • To understand the impact different language can have on the reader • To begin to apply 'writing for impact' to their own stories.
<p>Reading and Phonics</p> 	<p>We will be...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reading a range of key words on sight. • Using our knowledge of phonics to decode and blend unfamiliar words. • To understand and make predictions based on <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ a picture ○ a video ○ a text • To be able to summarise longer pieces of writing, starting with a page and ending with a chapter. • To answer test type questions.
<p>Numeracy</p> 	<p>Focus: Fractions</p> <p>We are learning about...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understanding what unit and non-unit fractions are and how to make a whole • Beginning to understand tenths as decimals • Learning how to work out fractions of objects • Understanding equivalent fractions • Answer reasoning questions related to adding and subtracting fractions
<p>Science</p> 	<p>Topic: Forces and magnets</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To compare how things move on different surfaces. • To notice that some forces need contact between two objects but magnetic forces can act at a distance. • To observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others. • To describe magnets as having two poles. • To predict whether two magnets will attract or repel each other, depending on which poles are facing.

In Computing the children are learning how to be good, safe communicators online, with the main focus on email.


RE and Collective Worship
