

### Year 5 Spring Term 2.2

<b>Maths</b>	We will be looking at fractions and decimals. The children will be adding and subtracting fractions. They will also compare and order fractions. Then they will move onto converting fractions proper and improper fractions.
<b>Reading</b>	We will begin the term with a new text – ‘Who Let The Gods Out’ which is linked to our Ancient Greek theme. To kick start the new text, children will make predictions and then move on to find the meaning of words in context. We will continue to build on the skills we have been looking at throughout this year such as inference and retrieval skills.
<b>English</b>	Next term will see the return of Literacy week and World Book Day, in which we will be exploring a range of books and text types. We will then look at journalistic writing and the different language and organisational features within this topic. We will build non-fiction based writing skills.
<b>Science</b>	We will be continuing with our Forces topic, focussing on water resistance, magnetism and buoyancy. They will carry out investigations and record their finding using a variety of ways e.g. graphs
<b>LFL</b>	In LFL, we will be continuing with our Ancient Greece topic. We will explore how people in this time lived, what they believed in and key events that took place.
<b>RE</b>	This term the children will study the Easter story and learn about the significance of Easter in the Christian faith. We will be discussing what new beginnings mean.
<b>Computing</b>	Our topic in computing this term is ‘We are Artists.’ Children will explore geometric art, using repeated patterns created on ‘Scratch.’ Alongside our computing sessions, children will be learning how to stay safe online.
<b>PE</b>	Please remember to bring your P.E. Kits in on a <b>Monday and Tuesday</b> . <b>5D</b> and <b>5K</b> will be going Swimming on Thursday’s and therefore need the appropriate kit.
<b>Homework</b>	We currently give homework out on a Friday and receive it back on a Wednesday. Children have 1 Maths piece and 1 Reading comprehension with spellings going out each week. Also, home reading diaries should be signed daily to notify the teacher that your child has read for 10-15mins at home.
