


### Writing:

This term we will be continuing to focus on improving the children's accuracy of using capital letters and full stops in their sentences as well as ensuring the children are leaving clear finger spaces between words. We will be ensuring that children are writing letters accurately and applying all they have learned in Phonics to their own writing. Children will be developing their use of compound sentences and exploring question marks and exclamation marks. This term we will be exploring the following:

- Stories from a range of cultures
- Information texts - The Victorians
- Poems on a theme

### Phonics:

The children are working in eight phonic groups across the year group. They are practising reading and writing their sounds daily. This term we will be launching Phonics Homework. Please look out for further information about this. We will be inviting parents in to school to share ways of helping their child with their phonics homework. This is particularly important as support and preparation for their Phonics Screening Check that will take place the week commencing 11th June 2018

### Reading:

Following the launch of Year 1s reading logs we are pleased to see lots of parents and family members reading with our children at home. All of the Year 1 staff appreciate the continued support we get from home to support our children. Please try to continue to help your child to remember to bring their book bag, reading books and reading logs to school every day.



### Numeracy:

We will be learning:

- Place value - securing the children's knowledge and understanding of numbers up to 100.
  - Finding 1 more and 1 less than a given number up to 100.
  - Counting forwards and backwards from a number.
  - Finding the missing numbers on a number line.
  - Reading and writing numbers in words.
- Children will be applying these skills to solve problems.

# Year 1 Term 2.1

## Computing:

During the Summer Term Year 1 will be learning the following units of work:

- \* We are painters - illustrating an eBook
- \* We are collectors - Finding images using the web

Children will have the opportunity to use desk top computers as well as ipads to learn different skills. Children will learn different techniques to create their own images and they will learn how to search for, select and copy images from the internet.

## RE:

The dispositions we will be looking at this term are:

- Remembering Roots (commitment)
- Being Hopeful and Visionary (commitment)



## PE:

We have PE sessions every **Monday and Thursday** morning. Please make sure that your child has ALL their PE kit in school on these days.

## Learning for Life:

Our theme this term is 'Kings, Queens and Castles'. This topic focuses on History this term. The children will learn about the monarchy and their roles and responsibilities. They will explore the timeline of different Kings and Queens and learn about our current monarchy. This will lead us to a big celebration for the Royal Wedding later in the term.



## Science:

The children will be learning about trees and plants. They will learn about the features of different trees and plants and compare similarities and differences between them. They will identify and learn to describe the basic structure of different plants and trees and label their different parts. They will then move on to discussing why we have plants and trees.
