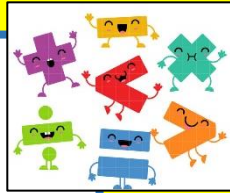


# This half term in Year 2 we are learning about...

## Numeracy:

We are learning about:

- Multiplication and division
- Addition and subtraction
- Position and direction
- Measurement
- 10x, 2x and 5x tables
- All work will involve problem solving.



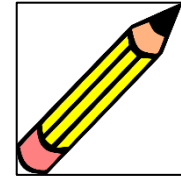
## Writing:

Genre: Explanation and Non chronological reports

The children will be looking at the story of 'Fantastic Mr Fox'.

We will learning:

- To use capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks and speech marks.
- To write using paragraphs.
- To extend sentences using 'if, when, but, because, or, that and then.
- To write using topic language and powerful descriptive language.
- To write using different sentence openers.



## Reading:

To answer and ask retrieval questions.  
To answer and ask 'who' and 'where' questions.  
To answer and ask 'what' and 'when' questions.  
To recall information about the characters.  
To become familiar with key stories, retelling them.  
To make inferences from the text.  
To understand different texts types and their vocabulary.  
Please try and read with your child and share their books together. Remember to sign the children's logs each time you hear them read.

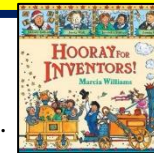
## Learning for Life:

Topic: Our Local Area

To be able to use a map to recognise a local area.  
To recognise different types of buildings and what they are used for.  
To ask and answer questions about the history of a local area.

## Science

Topic: Plants and Animals

To name a variety of plants.  
To name the different parts of a plant.  
To look at conditions needed for growth.  
To identify animals and their habitats.

## Computing

The children will continue to look at online safety by looking at how we can search safely on the internet.  
The children will also become photographers. In this unit they will learn how to look at images and what makes a good photograph. They will use ipads to take photos, learn how to edit them and evaluate the finished result.
