| Readingz | Your child will be read with twice a week. They will have their Guided Reading book changed at least once a week. They will<br>need to have their book bags in school <u>every day</u> so that a new book can be sent home. Please try and read this with your<br>child and share these books together.                                 |
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| Phonics: | The children are taught a phonic lesson daily for 30 minutes. The children will learn to segment and blend their word using their phonic knowledge. The children will learn tricky words and read these in sentences.   |
| Writing  | This term we will be focusing on the book 'Meerkat Mail'. For this text the children will be using a range of writing skills to<br>write a recount on Sid's journey. The children will also be celebrating World Book Day. The children will be focusing on the<br>story 'Zog' and dress up as their favorite character from the story. |
| Maths:   | <ul> <li>We will be learning:</li> <li>Measure and begin to record lengths and heights.</li> <li>Use and understand the language of length such as long, short, and tall.</li> <li>Compare, describe, and solve practical problems for lengths and heights</li> </ul>   |





| Science    | This half term the children will be learning about ' <b>Animals including humans'</b> . The children will be learning about humans.<br>They will label the basic features on a human body and look closely at the five senses. The children will carry out<br>experiences to explore the five senses — sight, smell, touch, hear and taste.   |
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| RE:        | The dispositions we will be looking at this term are:<br>Looking at the meaning of courage and what this means to them. They will look at how courage is portrayed in meaningful<br>stories. In the final part of the term, the children will look at the story of Easter and what it means to be a good friend.  |
| Non-Core:  | Our theme this term is 'Up, up and away'. In History the children will develop an understanding what transport is and its purpose. They will look at how transport has changed over time. They will look at a variety of inventors and the impact they have had on inventions around the world.   |
| PE:        | We have PE sessions every T <b>uesday</b> and T <b>hursday</b> , Please make sure that your child has their PE kit in school on these days.<br>Children need to bring - pumps/trainers, black joggers or leggings (for the colder weather), a black or white t-shirt and a<br>jumper or sweatshirt<br>Please can you make sure that all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name.<br>This term the children will be doing Gymnastics (indoors) and Ball skills (outdoors). |
| Computing: | <b>'We are story tellers'</b><br>This term we are learning to plan a story using a story board and use an iPad to insert digital media.   |
