

Writing

Poetic voice: Children will be immersed into different poems. This will help them to generate language and create mood for a poem that will write.

Balanced arguments: Children will be looking at different types of one sided and balanced arguments

Reading

Our focus text will be 'Street Child'. Children will be learning about the authors use of language choices and why these choices were made. Every week children will have an opportunity to answer questions based on a unseen text to prepare them for Year 6.

Mathematics

In maths, we will be learning about decimals, fraction and percentages. Children will be learning how to add and subtract different fractions as well as multiplying and dividing fractions. They will also learn to convert improper fractions to mixed numbers. In terms of percentages, they will learn to convert them into decimals and fractions. This will all lead into solving test-based questions.



Science

This term we will be looking at different forces such as air resistance, gravity, frictions including levers and pulleys.

Physical Development

Children will be moving onto tennis and cricket, where they will be learning a range of skills on using the bats and rackets. These skills will then lead the children to playing games where they can implement the skills they have been taught.

Learning For Life

Topic: Victorians

This term in LFL children will be learning about the Victorians.

LFL: Children will learn where the Victorian period began and ended, which countries were involved, what the people were like, how they dressed and looking at Victorian building structures. In Computing, we will be continuing to look at e-safety and in RE we will looking at the disposition 'Being open, honest and truthful'. This is linked with the value of the term: Honesty.
