








Term 3.1 Year 6

This half term in Year 6 we are learning about . . .

<p>Writing and Grammar</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The children will be focusing on narratives and creating their own Arabian Night story linked to our Early Islamic Civilisation topic.• Persuasive text- children will create their own persuasive holiday leaflet for Baghdad.• A letter of complaint- children will write a letter of complaint for a poor stay at a hotel.• We will continue to develop our vocabulary and writing style. All children will be developing their structural and organisational skills when paragraphing.
<p>Reading and Spelling</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We will focus on texts linked to our LFL topic (Early Islamic Civilisation)• Children will read the following texts Arabian Nights , Aladdin and The Wise Fool to develop vocabulary through challenging texts..• Using a range of texts, we will answer questions, making reference to the text.• We will learn spelling rules for pluralisation, prefixes and suffixes. There will also be a focus on spelling the Year 5 and 6 key words.
<p>Numeracy</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To develop our knowledge on fractions, decimals and percentages.• To work systematically to solve problems in different contexts.• To develop our arithmetic and reasoning skills.
