## Home learning:

Lots of you have been asking for more work for your children to complete at home. In response to this, we have added a lot of new content for children in all year groups. We are continuing to review what is on the website and ensuring that it is purposeful and supportive to you and your children. In adding work, we are not trying to add pressure to any parents who are finding home-schooling challenging but instead are putting it there to support you if you need it.

We have recently added mandarin learning packs on the website so that children in Y3 and Y5 can continue with this area of learning alongside other curriculum areas. In addition to this, we have shared the links to the Oak National Academy where there are daily lessons for different curriculum areas that are delivered by teachers from across the country. There are also BBC bitesize links that have been shared too if you wish to use them.

We are aware that not everyone will be able to access or complete the online learning and understand the potential issues with this. To support with this, we have printed some paper packs that you are able to collect if you contact us via the email address above. A really important message that we wish to share is that we only expect you to do what you can whilst ensuring that your children and families are safe and well.
